Dear Rachel:

I am delighted to inform you that the Admissions Committee, having reviewed and evaluated your academic accomplishments, personal achievements, and potential for legal studies, has accepted you for admission to the College of Law.

Through your academic achievement, aptitude, and strength of personal qualities, you have demonstrated a fine potential for legal studies and service to the legal profession. I commend you, Rachel, on such noteworthy qualifications and enthusiastically join the Admissions Committee in wishing you every success. Welcome to the DePaul community and to the full-time day program Class of 2027!

I am also thrilled to inform you that, in recognition of your achievements, personal qualities, and potential to contribute to the DePaul community, the College of Law will award you a Dean's Scholarship in the total amount of \$120,000. The Dean's Scholarship will be applied toward tuition in the amount of \$40,000 for the 2024-2025 academic year. This award is guaranteed in the same amount for your two remaining academic years provided that you are enrolled as a full-time student in good academic standing. There is no GPA requirement to renew this award.

During the next several weeks, you will be devoting a good deal of time to assessing the criteria that you value in a law school. I encourage you at any time to contact the Office of Admissions. We understand that selecting a law school involves a number of considerations and commitments, both on a professional and a personal level. To confirm your acceptance and to hold your seat in the entering class, you must submit in a timely manner a total tuition deposit of one thousand dollars, which may be paid in two equal installments of five hundred dollars. Your tuition deposit is non-refundable and will be applied toward your tuition for the Fall Semester. Please ensure your deposit is received in the Office of Admissions on or before Monday, April 15, 2024. You may pay your tuition deposit online through Campus Connection at <https://campusconnect.depaul.edu>. Your DePaul Campus Connection username and password are enclosed.

Should you elect to pay the tuition deposit in two installments, the second deposit must be received on or before Monday, June 17, 2024. Should you fail to submit these deposit installments by the required dates, you may lose your seat. To accept your scholarship award, please sign and submit the enclosed 2024-2025 Dean's Scholarship Award Form to the Office of Admissions by sending an electronic copy of the signed form by email to lawinfo@depaul.edu.

The American Bar Association requires that the law school in which you enroll have an official and final copy of your undergraduate transcript that posts your undergraduate degree. If you submitted your undergraduate college transcript to LSAC prior to having completed your degree, you must request that your university send another official transcript to LSAC by August 1, 2024 which shows that your undergraduate degree was completed. LSAC will update your JD CAS report with your final transcript and verify conferral of your baccalaureate degree.

Once again, I commend you on your accomplishments and congratulate you on your admission to the full-time day program. You join a distinguished DePaul community of students, scholars, professors, and alumni. I am confident that you will find DePaul College of Law and the city of Chicago to be stimulating settings in which to achieve your academic, professional, and personal goals.
